

Stop Food Scraps from Contributing to Global Warming!

If 1,000 families put all of their food scraps in a Green Cone, they would keep the equivalent of 1900 tons of CO₂ out of the atmosphere. That's the same as taking about 400 cars off of the road each year!

Using a Green Cone is easy!

The Green Cone takes it all—including meat, fish, dairy, and bones. Once installed you simply open the lid, add food scraps, and close the lid. Half of the cone is buried in the ground where micro-organisms digest the material, releasing the nutrients directly into the soil. No turning or special recipes required!

Green Cones cost \$76.85 each, including 6% VT sales tax. (The average retail price is \$150 per cone with shipping—which means this price is almost 50% less than retail!)
