MATERIAL	ACCEPTABLE	PREPARATION	NOT ACCEPTABLE
<b>Tin/Aluminum</b>	All food and beverage tin and aluminum cans, clean pie pans and other aluminum foil sheets.	Rinse clean, empty	Aerosol cans, scrap metal
<b>Glass</b>	Clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars.	Rinse clean, empty	Window/mirror glass, glassware, food or drink
<b>Plastic- 4 categories</b>	colored,  natural, and  containers. Check bottom of container for recycling number. Rinse clean, empty and replace lid on all plastics.	Rinse clean, empty and replace lid	Anything < 2" in diameter; , , , or  plastics; oil & antifreeze jugs
<b>Boxes/brown paper</b>	Cardboard packing boxes, cereal/snack boxes and brown paper.	Break down (flatten)	Stuck-on food, milk/juice cartons, coffee cups, white or wax-coated boxes
<b>White &amp; other paper</b>	Newspaper, magazines, office paper, mail & envelopes, soft-cover books and catalogs. Reduce junk mail @ <a href="http://catalogchoice.com">catalogchoice.com</a>	Keep loose, dump out of bag	Plastic bags/sleeves, single-use/disposable paper products (napkins, plates, cups, etc.)

<b>Clothing/Textiles and Shoes</b>	Clean and dry delivered in clear plastic bags.
<b>Electronics/Appliances</b>	TVs, printers, computers, and peripherals (monitor, keyboard, mouse) at no cost. Other electronics, appliances and electric cords will have a nominal charge. 80% metal go in scrap metal (i.e. microwaves). <i>More info:</i> <a href="http://rcswd.com/electronics">rcswd.com/electronics</a>
<b>Food Waste</b>	Food scraps, fruits, vegetables, dairy, bread, grains, meat and bones, oils, sauces, eggs, coffee grounds, and filters. <i>More info:</i> <a href="http://rcswd.com/food-scraps">rcswd.com/food-scraps</a>
