MATERIAL	ACCEPTABLE	PREPARATION	NOT ACCEPTABLE
Tin/Aluminum	All food and beverage tin and aluminum cans, clean pie pans and other aluminum foil sheets.	Rinse clean, empty	Aerosol cans, scrap metal
Glass	Clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars.	Rinse clean, empty	Window/mirror glass, glassware, food or drink
Plastic- 4 categories	♻️, ♻️ colored, ♻️ natural, and ♻️ containers. Check bottom of container for recycling number. Rinse clean, empty and replace lid on all plastics.	Rinse clean, empty and replace lid	Anything < 2" in diameter; ♻️, ♻️, ♻️, or ♻️ plastics; oil & antifreeze jugs
Boxes/brown paper	Cardboard packing boxes, cereal/snack boxes and brown paper.	Break down (flatten)	Stuck-on food, milk/juice cartons, coffee cups, white or wax-coated boxes
White & other paper	Newspaper, magazines, office paper, mail & envelopes, soft-cover books and catalogs. Reduce junk mail @ catalogchoice.com	Keep loose, dump out of bag	Plastic bags/sleeves, single-use/disposable paper products (napkins, plates, cups, etc.)

Clothing/Textiles and Shoes	Clean and dry delivered in clear plastic bags.
Electronics/Appliances	TVs, printers, computers, and peripherals (monitor, keyboard, mouse) at no cost. Other electronics, appliances and electric cords will have a nominal charge. 80% metal go in scrap metal (i.e. microwaves). <i>More info: rcswd.com/electronics</i>
Food Waste	Food scraps, fruits, vegetables, dairy, bread, grains, meat and bones, oils, sauces, eggs, coffee grounds, and filters. <i>More info: rcswd.com/food-scraps</i>
